Furniture Care Guide



Spruce's commitment to you is to deliver each piece of furniture in like-new condition. At the end of every subscription, we fully sanitize and disinfect our furniture, and refurbish them if needed, so that they can arrive at their home in amazing condition.

To help you better take care of your furniture during your subscription period, we have created a simple guide on some ways to prolong the life of your items and maintain regular upkeep.



General

It is always great to keep a clean cloth and a gentle vacuum on hand for universal maintenance of your furniture. Please be aware that placing furniture in direct sunlight or near air vents can unintentionally cause discoloration and scorching damage.

Wood Furniture

For regular dusting and upkeep, use a dry cloth. In case of a spill, use a damp cloth to gently dab the affected area. Dry with a soft clean cloth. Do not use abrasive products when cleaning. We always recommend protecting surfaces with coasters, mouse pads, or placemats as extreme and repetitive daily use or heat can damage the finish.



Sofas & Textiles

In case of a stain, use a clean and slightly damp white cloth, blotting from the outer edges of the affected area to the center. Pat dry with a soft clean cloth. Water-based or solvent cleaners may cause discoloration or staining.

Rugs

Maintain rugs by keeping them away from direct sunlight, with occasional sweeping or vacuuming to reduce dust. Occasionally rotate rugs when vacuuming for even wear.

Leather

To maintain the quality of your leather, avoid saturating the leather with lotion or water for a long period of time as leather is a porous material that is sometimes uncoated and can easily absorb liquids and oily substances. Care for leather by dusting the surface. Please avoid using chemical cleaners as this can permanently damage the leather. Be sure to keep away from direct sunlight.



Metals

Only use fine cotton or extra soft cloths to clean metals. Gentle wiping is adequate for regular maintenance. Never use cleaners with alcohols or solvents on metals.

Stone

Always use placemats or coasters when using objects that may scratch the surface of stone. Clean surfaces with a damp soft cloth. For spills, always blot with a soft cloth immediately to prevent stain absorption. Please be aware that any common foods and drinks contain acids that will etch or dull the surface of many stones.



Glass & Crystal

Glass and crystal can be cleaned by gently wiping with a soft damp cloth or glass cleaner. Apply glass cleaner to a soft cloth rather than directly on to the fixture to avoid overspray that may damage other finishes.

Lighting Shades

Dust with a dry soft cloth to minimize dust.
